To lead a project or work alone you must:

- be a business registered in England, Wales or Northern Ireland
- be the end beneficiary of the study, and operate a site in England, Wales or Northern Ireland which fits into one of these categories of activity:
 - manufacturing (SIC codes 10000 through to 33200)
 - data centre (SIC code 63110) .

Businesses are allocated a standard industrial classification (SIC) code when they register with Companies House.
