

EPSRC EQUALITY, DIVERSITY AND INCLUSION STRATEGIC ADVISORY ROUTES

We primarily draw on the expertise from within our advisory groups (Council, SETB, SAN and SAT's) to provide us with strategic advice on Equality, Diversity and Inclusion. Our approach facilitates a flexible resource enabling us to obtain the advice we need in a timely manner, drawing on a range of perspectives from across our key stakeholder groups, with the specific goal of:

- providing strategic advice that will support the development of evidence based actions, determining what challenges to prioritise and identify areas where EPSRC is uniquely placed to deliver change in the academic community;
- enhancing our understanding of activities in the broader landscape and how EPSRC
 can work effectively within a complex landscape of activity. Alerting us to new and
 emerging areas or opportunities and helping us identify new stakeholders we might work
 with from across the sector;
- acting as advocates for EPSRC's EDI approach and help two-way communication between EPSRC and the broader community.

Our EDI advisory meetings are chaired by a member of EPSRC Council with members drawn from our advisory groups, as described above, and supplemented by additional external expertise as required.

People bring their own expertise and experience of equality, diversity and inclusion in research to this group, but are required to act as 'generous generalists', bringing a broad strategic view and advising across the breadth of the EPSRC portfolio.

EVOLUTION

To ensure we have a diversity of voices advising us on our EDI activities and plans we have evolved our approach to work more closely with our SAT's and other stakeholders.
