Notice of supplementary funding

- 1. Research England has received additional funding from the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy (BEIS) for financial year 2022-23, supplementary to the funding allocated in August 2022¹. Given the current pressures, we are pleased to provide £31.4 million of Supplementary quality-related research (QR) funding and £3.87 million of Supplementary Research Capital Investment Fund (RCIF) grants to eligible higher education providers (HEPs).
- 2. These supplementary allocations are not related to the Additional QR and Additional RCIF allocations to address ongoing uncertainty over access to EU programmes, which were communicated on 28 November 2022².

Supplementary QR funding

3. All HEPs in receipt of an allocation of QR funding for 2022-23 will receive an allocation of Supplementary QR.

- 6. All HEPs in receipt of an allocation from RCIF for 2022-23 will receive an allocation of Supplementary RCIF.
- 7. The £3.87 million is allocated in proportion to total RCIF grant allocations for 2022-23.
