#### Notice of supplementary funding

1. Research England has received further funding from the Department for Science, Innovation and Technology (DSIT) for financial year 2022-23, supplementary to the funding allocated in August 2022<sup>1</sup> and December 2022<sup>2</sup>. Given the ongoing pressures, we are pleased to provide a further £25 million of Supplementary Research Capital Investment Fund (RCIF) grants to eligible higher education providers (HEPs).
2. These supplementary allocations are not related to the Additional RCIF allocations to address ongoing uncertainty over access to EU programmes, which were communicated on 28 November 2022<sup>3</sup>.
3. All HEPs in receipt of an allocation from RCIF for 2022-23 will receive a second allocation of Supplementary RCIF.
4. The £25 million is allocated in proportion to total RCIF grant allocations for 2022-23.

6. Allocations may be spent against any eligible capital costs incurred between 1 April 2022 and 31 March 2023.
7. No additional monitoring will be undertaken on this funding; any monitoring will form part of our standard monitoring processes for RCIF.
