- Practice-based research, or research in partnership with design and craft practitioners, that enhances understanding of, and reinvigorates, traditional and contemporary technologies and making






Under-represented histories of local &

- Interrogating colonial intellectual inequalities perpetuated by library cataloguing structures and guidelines, terminologies and classifications
